## 0402 Doctor of Philosophy in Education

Shift : Afternoon  
 Duration : 3 years, 6 semesters, 30 credit hours  
 Eligibility : M.Phil (Education) with Research thesis in the relevant field or equivalent qualification with CGPA 3.00 /4.00 from any HEC recognized University and ETS – GRE (Subject) passed with 50 Percent percentile or NTS- GAT (Subject) with 60% marks.

The requirement of the Ph.D. Programme will be at least 6 Semesters with an extension of upto two Semesters by the Vice Chancellor in special circumstances. The minimum duration of 6 Semesters can be reduced to 4 Semesters in special cases on the basis of years of schooling, length of teaching / research experience, number of publications, etc on the recommendation of the Supervisory Committee.

Ph.D degree will be granted on successful completion of high caliber research work, which shall represent a real contribution to human knowledge. The statement of the problem (synopsis) must be submitted & finalized before the end of 1st semester. The scholar shall pursue research work for at least 4 semesters, under the guidance of a Supervisory Committee. Dissertation for the Ph.D. degree will not be accepted earlier than 6th semester, except in special cases as mentioned, from the date of admission in the doctoral degree programme. Dissertation will be evaluated by at least two experts from technologically advanced foreign countries and acceptance / publication of at least one research paper in any of the Indexed Journals. There will be a public defense of the student's research work.
